

Rules of the SHAKE TO WIN competition

ARTICLE 1: organisation

SEVABEL, a ski lift company with registered offices at BP 2 – LES MENUIRES – 73442 LES BELLEVILLE CEDEX France, is organising a free competition with no purchase obligation at its sales outlets located at the premises of its resort partners from 16/12/2017 to 27/04/2018

ARTICLE 2: participation

Participation in the competition is free and without obligation and is open to all natural persons (apart from employees and representatives of the organising company, its partners and sub-contractors, their consultants and members of their family) with a valid email address and mobile phone number, surname, first name and country. For minors under the age of 15, participation in the competition is at the responsibility and with the permission of a legal representative who is able to provide proof of parental authority.

Participation is on a strictly individual basis and the participant may not play on behalf of other participants. Incomplete or illegible entries will be considered as null and void.

ARTICLE 3: procedure

To take part, log on to www.skipass-lesmenuires.me and enter your competition code. This code is provided on little coupons distributed at our sales outlets. All you need to do to enter the draw is to fill in your details on the website, validating your entry by giving your consent.

ARTICLE 4: prizes

The competition operates via the distribution of little coupons with a unique code at sales outlets. The competition offers the following prizes:

A pair of skis (€300)

A ski helmet (€80)

20 first tracks (€15x20=€300)

20 1-day skipasses (€60x20= €1,200)

20 Roc'n Bob snow luge descents (€11x20 = €220)

Unlimited Speedmountain rail luge descents (€8 per run)

Any services other than those referred to above are to be paid for by the winner and their companions. Information supplied by participants to enter the competition will be used by the organising company SEVABEL to provide participants with the best available offers.

ARTICLE 5: declaration of winners

One competition winner will be declared each week, and the draw will be made by the Sevabel marketing department on the Friday morning and announced on the same day. Sevabel will inform winners of the results by email or phone. If they do not respond within 10 days of confirmation of their win, the winner or winners will be disqualified and any prizes will be lost. The list of winners will be available from Sevabel on request.

There are no cash or other alternatives available to the prizes, which are non-transferable. Competition prizes must be accepted as such and cannot be exchanged or replaced by a cash payment.

However, in a case of force majeure, Sevabel reserves the right to replace the advertised prizes with prizes equivalent in value. Participants will be informed via the email address entered on their entry form. They will be asked for their address via the email entered on the entry form supplied by Sevabel and completed by the participant. If a winner has provided false information regarding their identity or address, they and any of their entries will be declared null and void.

Participants hereby authorise the organiser to publish their details if they win and as an automatic result of their participation. This will not entitle them to anything other than the prize they have won.

ARTICLE 6

Participation in the competition implies full, unrestricted and unconditional acceptance of these rules.

As the event organiser, SEVABEL reserves the right to shorten, extend, postpone, modify or cancel the competition if circumstances require it to do so, in a case of force majeure or events beyond its control. None of the entities shall be held liable as a result of this.

SEVABEL will not be liable if the www.skipass-lesmenuires.me web site becomes temporarily unavailable during the competition. In particular, but not exclusively, Sevabel will not be liable if you are unable to enter your code because of transmission problems or for any other technical reason not reasonably within its control; nor will it be liable for typographic errors.

ARTICLE 7: legal deposit

The rules can be obtained free of charge by writing to SEVABEL.

Subject to the stated conditions, the organiser may change the rules at any time via an amendment issued in an online announcement on the web. It will come into force when it is posted online or made available in the organising company's sales outlets. Through their participation in the competition, participants will automatically be considered to have accepted the change from when it came into force. Participants objecting to any changes must cease their participation in the competition.

Article 8: award of prizes

By accepting their prize, winners authorise SEVABEL to use their last name, first name, email or phone number in any promotional initiative relating to the competition without such use giving rise to any form of compensation other than the prize won. This will apply for a maximum period of 1 year.

ARTICLE 9: connection and use

In application of the Law of 6 January 1978 relating to Information Technology and Data Protection, participants have the right to access, rectify and cancel information collected in this way and have the option to object to the transfer thereof. ARTICLE 10: jurisdiction

Participants are subject to French legislation applicable to games and competition. Any dispute that cannot be settled amicably will be submitted to the competent courts designated in accordance with the French Code of Civil Procedure.

Jurisdiction will be assigned to the Court of Albertville for any dispute over the interpretation or execution of these rules and where no prior conciliation can be achieved with the organiser.
